

Jacob Dawson Team Plymouth Update

Since I last wrote, things have been moving forward quickly.

After being selected for Final GB Trials to earn a place in the British Junior World Championship team, I attended the National Schools Regatta in Nottingham, despite conditions being challenging with winds reaching up to 30mph, I qualified for the final of the J17 Single Sculls, and came home with a silver medal, gaining a larger lead over people who were close to me at the start of the year.

My home club Plymouth Amateur Rowing Club (P.A.R.C), held the Plymouth Regatta on the 11th June. Over the course of the day I had some very pleasing results. I managed to win the Men's Senior B Single Scull and also the Men's Senior A Single Scull beating some much older and far more experienced rowers than myself.

Finally, the biggest achievement I have gained so far is being asked to take part in a Quad at Henley Royal Regatta, in which the three other crew members have already gained junior national honours, two of these three have represented Great Britain at the Junior World Championships and the other represented Great Britain in the European Championships.
